IGCSE Maths Intervention Year 11	Support students with revision and exam practice
Peer Mentors	A Peer to Peer community support that caters to social and emotional wellbeing. The Peer mentors offer support through Listening circles and Facilitating wellbeing sessions. Students are chosen by interviews conducted by existing peer mentors and are monitored by the school counselor
Student Council	A group of students elected by the student body as representatives their representatives in the larger school community. They work closely with the pastoral team to integrate student voice through the year
Food Theory Intervention	AN opportunity for food and nutrition students to revise/brush up on their food and nutrition theory and understanding
MFL Intervention	MFL intervention and speaking practice for Y10 GCSE Spanish students
GCSE Spanish Speaking Intervention	Lunchtime - an opportunity for Year 11 students to practice their speaking skills throughout the year. Students will sign up in pairs for a 10 minute slot with their teacher on one lunchtime per week

Islamic Studies	Quran recitation Rules- Seerah - Prophet's stories






