




Tailored pathways for Years 7-9

The British Curriculum Overview

There are three key stages that allow for students to refine their subject choices over time. Our leavers will have the opportunity to study a range of GCSE, BTEC, ASDAN, and A-Level qualifications which will provide them with an 'educational passport' to further their studies anywhere in the world.



Key Stage 3 (Year 7-9)

Our Key Stage 3 (Years 7-9) provides a range of subjects in which knowledge and skills are developed to ensure essential preparation for GCSE courses in Key Stage 4 (Years 10-11). We are delighted with our Key Stage 5 centre that opened in September 2024, and the suite of A-Level courses on offer to help prepare students for their university studies. The teaching team is comprised of specialist staff, who combine research-based practice with innovation, ensuring that students are supported and challenged at every stage of their educational journey.

The Use of Technology

Digital Literacy is a vital skill for the 21st century. The use of technology and social media has huge potential in today's society, but with this potential comes a certain degree of risk. At Safa British School, we deliver safe ICT usage around the 7 pillars of our Digital Literacy Framework.







The Core Curriculum

- Swimming





Student Support


Student Support and Parent Communication




Class Charts






Exceptional GCSE Results


